from Greece, the company has grown into a nationally recognized brand represented by over 400 distributors and offering more than 300 products.

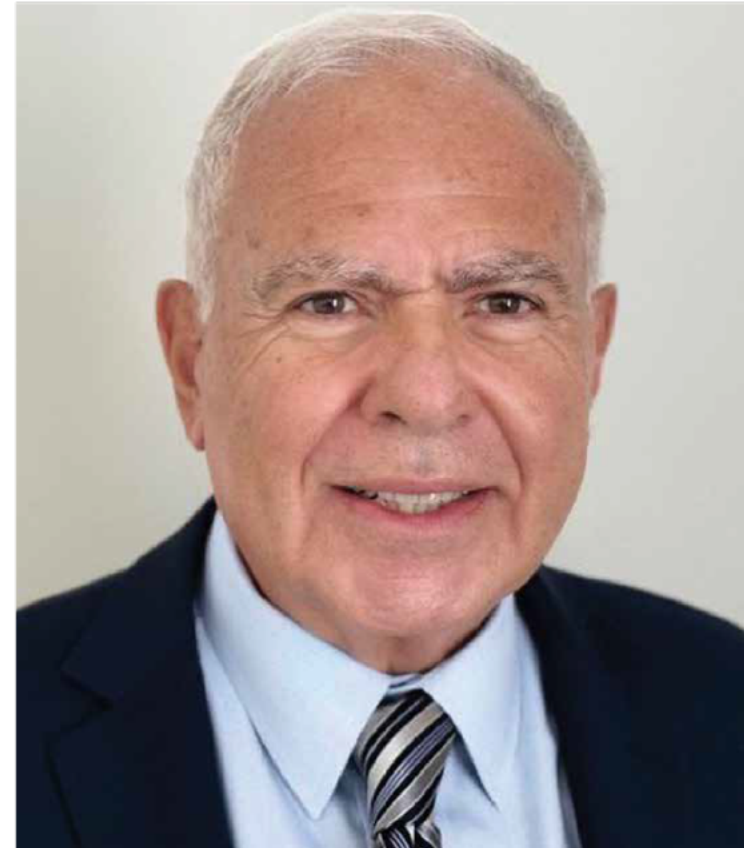

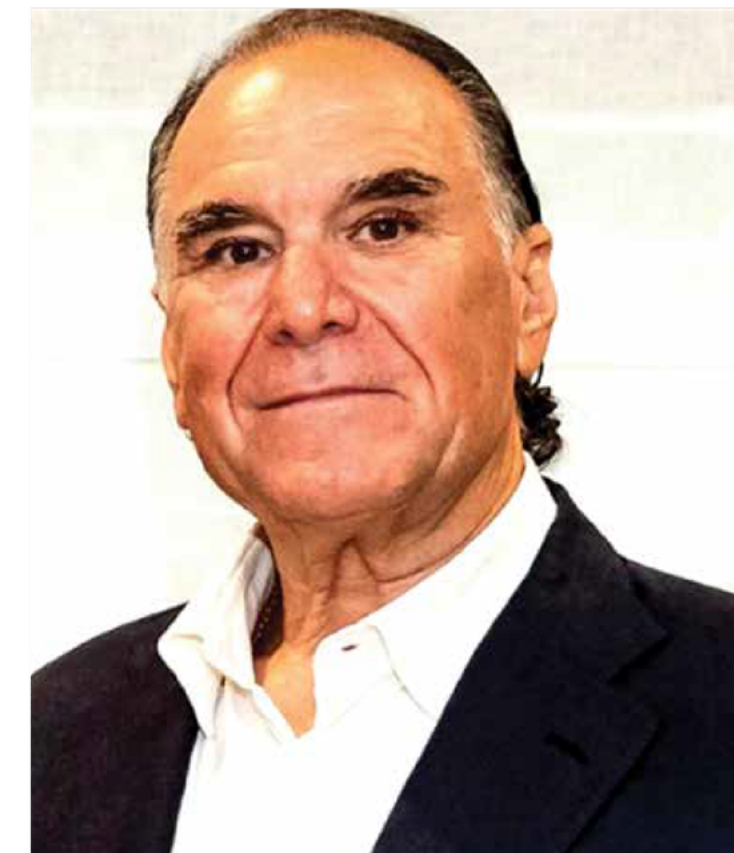
Kramvis is known for effecting major company turnarounds and for introducing leading edge technologies. He is the recipient of the 2017 Society of Chemical Industry Medal partly for his leadership in the introduction of low global warming refrigerants currently in use worldwide. He has also served as an Operating Partner with AEA Investors, a New York private equity firm, and has earlier worked in venture capital. Kramvis currently serves as Advisor and Board Member to several companies. An author on management, in his book 'Transforming the Corporation: Running a Business in the 21st Century', he describes how to systematically transform a business for high performance.

Kramvis grew up in Cyprus and studied and worked in the UK before moving to the United States. He is a graduate of Cambridge University in Engineering with a specialization in Electronics and holds an MBA from the Manchester Business School. He and his wife Shirley met while at Cambridge, have three grown-up children and they currently reside in Palm Beach Gardens, FL. Together they co-chair the Andreas and Shirley Kramvis Foundation which supports various philanthropic causes including many in Greece and Cyprus.

When Kramvis presented a lecture on his book to the Greek American Chamber of Commerce and the Association for Corporate Growth he emphasized that "you must train people to think positively about the future" - a philosophy THI is working to convey to the people of Greece, especially its youth.

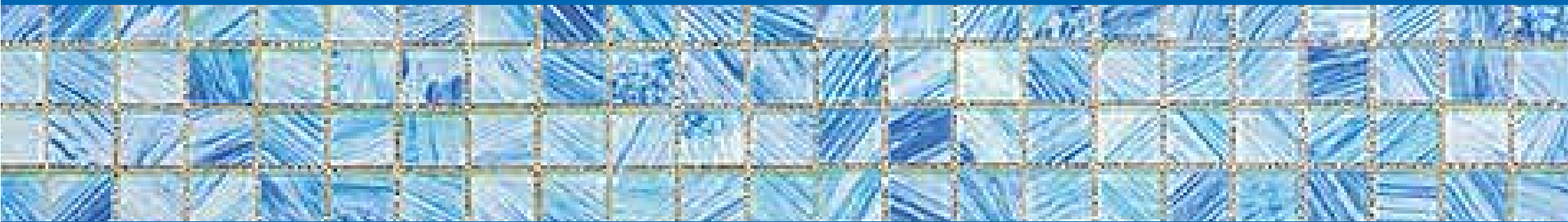

\$2.7 Million Raised To Support Greece

The Hellenic Initiative (THI) raised a record-breaking \$2.7 million through a series of events in New York City December 5-8 dedicated to THI's mission of investing in the future of Greece. The events shined a powerful spotlight on Greece's remarkable progress and ongoing challenges that the global Greek diaspora continues to address through THI's transparent, trusted and impactful funding. For THI is not just a relief for everything Greece has endured but a beacon of hope for everything Greece can become.

13TH ANNUAL THI NEW YORK GALA



The Hellenic Initiative's 13th Annual New York Gala brought together more than 865 supporters from across the global Greek diaspora at Cipriani Wall Street for a sold-out evening celebrating unity, philanthropy, and impact. The gala served as the centerpiece of a record-breaking New York fundraising weekend that raised \$2.7 million to support THI's mission of investing in Greece's future.

Guests heard remarks from THI leadership, including Co-Founder and President George P. Stamas and Co-Founder and Chairman Andrew N. Liveris, while His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros delivered the evening's invocation. A special highlight of the night was the presentation of the THI Lifetime Achievement Award to entrepreneur John Payiavlas, honoring his leadership, philanthropy, and dedication to the Hellenic community.

The evening also featured a short film narrated by Hugh Jackman, celebrating THI's impact and vision for the future, before guests concluded the night with vibrant entertainment and celebration.

The evening highlighted the success of ReGeneration, the pioneering employment initiative co-founded by THI and Coca-Cola in 2014 to address youth unemployment and support young professionals in Greece. Over the past decade, ReGeneration has grown into the country's largest upskilling and placement program for graduates, helping thousands launch meaningful careers.

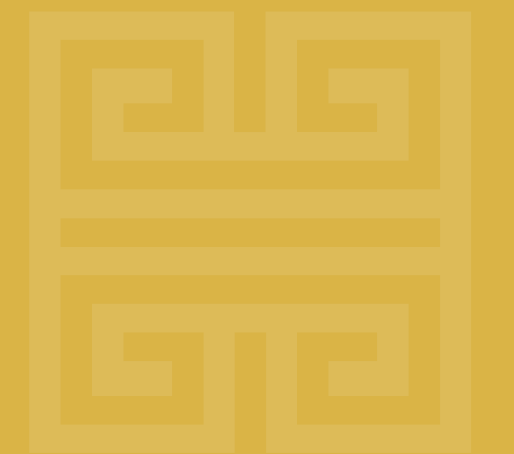
The dinner marked an important new tradition for THI, celebrating the vital role corporate partnerships play in expanding opportunity and strengthening Greece's future.

In 2025, The Hellenic Initiative's grantmaking surpassed \$1 million, balancing immediate relief with long-term growth. While our operations remain anchored in Greece's urban centers, we are steadily extending our footprint into remote regions to ensure our impact is felt nationwide.

Our work is built on two distinct pillars. First, we provide essential humanitarian aid, addressing critical needs in food security, healthcare, child protection, and environmental restoration. Second, we drive economic development by investing in job creation, entrepreneurship, and workforce training. At the heart of these efforts is a venture philanthropy approach, where we support scalable programs with measurable outcomes to help our partners expand their reach.

Although Greece has made significant progress, regional inequalities and economic insecurity remain. We are deeply grateful to our supporters for helping us build a more resilient and inclusive future for all of Greece.

NEW AGRICULTURE NEW GENERATION

Cultivating Resilience: Chios Mastiha & Rural Innovation

The Hellenic Initiative recognizes that Greece's rural communities are the nation's heartbeat. Our work in agriculture focuses on empowering the people who work the land with the knowledge and networks needed to thrive in a modern economy. By supporting specialized technical training, we ensure that Greece's unique agricultural treasures—and the communities that safeguard them—remain vibrant and sustainable.

Our partnership with New Agriculture New Generation focuses on the unique Mastiha industry of Chios. This project utilizes a sophisticated peer-to-peer model designed for maximum scalability and community trust.

Under this framework, a core group of 24 lead growers receives intensive, expert-led training. These leaders are then tasked with transferring that knowledge to 300 of their peers, while broader open-training sessions ensure that modern techniques reach the entire island. This approach goes beyond sharing information; it builds a stronger, more connected professional network among the growers themselves.

FOOD BANK

Fighting Food Insecurity: Scaling Impact with Food Bank Greece

Despite Greece's broader economic recovery, food insecurity remains a persistent challenge, with one in ten Greeks still struggling to access consistent, nutritious meals. Through a long-standing partnership with Food Bank Greece (FBG) and the generous support of the Andreas and Shirley Kramvis Foundation, The Hellenic Initiative has committed over \$400,000 since 2021 to support those living below the poverty line.

Our support is two-fold: we provide direct funding to "plug the gap" by purchasing essential foodstuffs that are rarely donated by corporations, and we invest in the operational infrastructure of the Food Bank itself. By funding the CTC (Click to Care) software platform, THI has helped FBG digitize its logistics, ensuring that aid is distributed with maximum efficiency across their massive network of soup kitchens, children's foundations, and elder care homes.

Community in Motion: The Giant Heart Roadshow & 2025 Academy Launch

This specialized technology is critical for advanced treatments like CAR-T cells, providing a vital lifeline to children requiring bone marrow transplants.

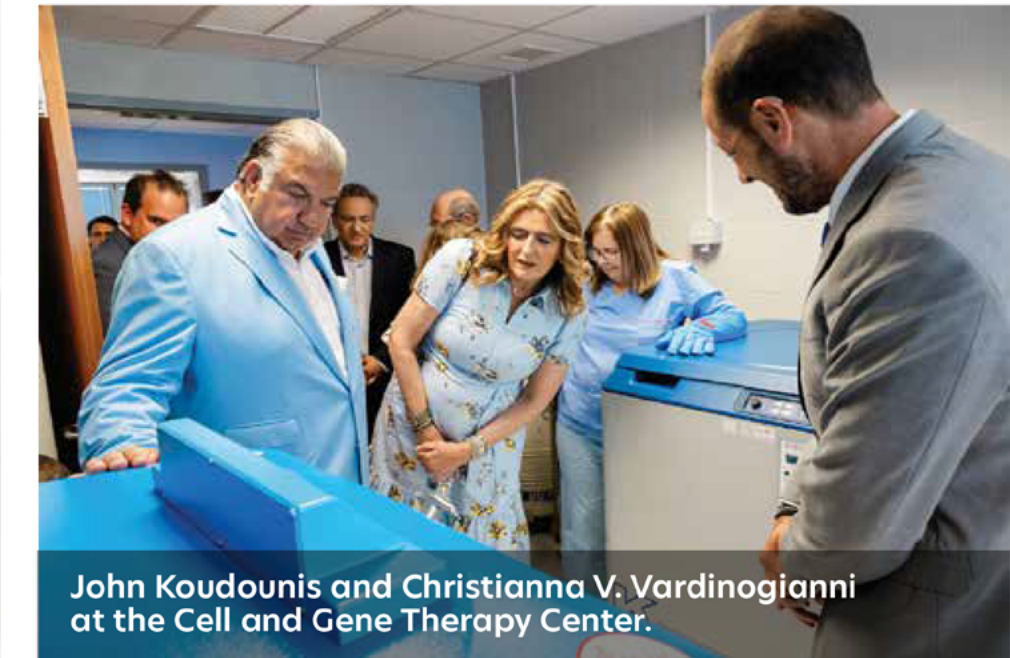

Global Bridges: The 2025 "Greeking Out" Series with Endeavor

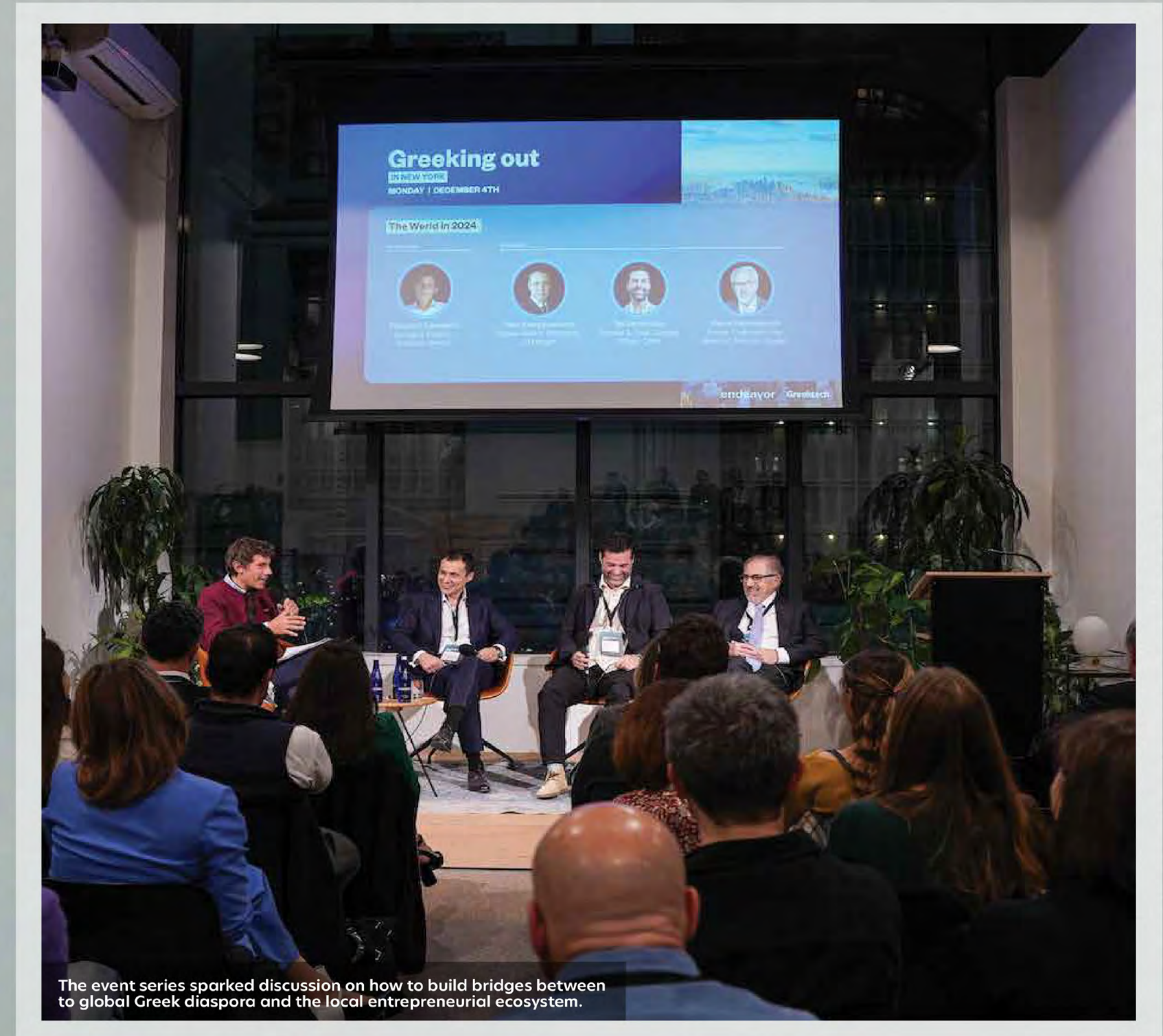
